Summer Panther Camp

For children entering grades PreK-6 in fall 2010.

June 14 - August 26, 2010

Program Hours: 7am - 6pm

Panther Camp is a fun opportunity for your child to spend the day in a nurturing environment while participating in exciting summer adventures. We offer a full-day camp program with flexible daily or weekly care options. Kids will spend the day participating in age-group-specific activities such as arts and crafts, sports, group games, and weekly field trips. Our program offers different weekly themes that let kids explore nature, science, the arts and so much more. We have air-conditioned facilities, a gym, and a kitchen for cooking projects. We are surrounded by 32 acres of land with a beautiful playground and enough grounds to facilitate all of the outdoor activities. On-campus enrichment includes experiences in musical instruction, artistic direction and even horse-back riding opportunities! Off-campus field trips include regional parks, museums, theaters, zoos, professional sporting events, and amusement parks just to name a few! By registering for a full week you save \$50!

Panther Camp cost is \$55/day or \$225/week per child. Weekly fee includes all field trip admissions, program supplies, and daily crafts.

Panther Camp is open from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily. Healthy snacks, drinks and milk are provided throughout the day, but children should bring their own cold lunch. Please do not send a lunch that must be heated or cooked. We ask that children bring a swimsuit, towel and water bottle each day.

Panther Camp runs from June 14 through August 26, with the exception of the three weeks that we offer summer classes: June 21-25, June 28-July 2 and August 9-13. During those weeks, you may sign your child up for a full day of classes with extended care in the morning and afternoon, if needed. The before-care program runs from 7-9 am, and the after-care program runs from 3:30 to 6 pm. Please refer to the summer program brochure for details.

Registration and Payment are Easy

Below are listed the weekly themes. Simply fill out **one registration form per child** and send it in with your check to secure your place. Subsequent payments are due on or before the Monday of the week of service. If your child does not attend on Monday, it is your responsibility to submit payment prior to the week of service. You may send payment in advance. *Please make checks or money orders payable to Mounds Park Academy. Please remit to Receptionists in the Front Office.* We cannot bill for Summer Panther Camp; we apologize for any inconvenience.

Non-Payment and Termination

If payment is not received by the due date, your child's attendance will be stopped and you will have full responsibility for all registered days. No refunds will be given if your child is registered for any day(s) or week(s) but does not attend during that time. This is necessary to ensure proper planning and staffing.

Panther Camp 2010 Themes

Fairytales and Fables: June 14-18

Superheroes come in all shapes and sizes, and we will learn about them through comics, music, stories, and role-playing. We will even create our very own superhero to present to the group at our "superhero" ball at the end of the week!



Creative Campers: July 26-30

Become a real Panther Camper. Experience the teamwork it takes to pitch a tent or cook over a campfire. Participate in campfire songs, stories and crafts. If you like camping, we would love to have you join us this week!

Oopy Goopy Week: August 2-6
