

Middle School Supply List for 2020-2021

GENERAL NOTES for Families

- Please label everything clearly with the student's full name.
- All middle school students will receive an **MPA student planner** on the first day of school. There is no additional charge for this.
- You do **NOT** need to purchase any textbooks, novels, or workbooks except for Orchestra students, as noted below. If a school issued workbook or textbook is lost, the student may be asked to pay for its replacement.
- Supplies specific to a project or disciplinary curriculum will be provided by MPA (i.e. art supplies, Microbits © kits, science materials, etc).
- IMPORTANT: All students must have a personal pair of earbuds that can be used with their computer. We will not be able to loan/borrow earbuds.
