Next week will be the final push for the fall campaign.

Philanthropy is so important – tuition only funds 82%, so support is needed for enrichment

We are a non-profit school

\$600,000 goal – fall campaign and the spring auction are the 2 big pushes \$100,000 goal for Give to the Max Day

2 – Past month events

Halloween Party – success

LS parent ed event – had about 12 parents in attendance. 2 at the night time meeting (1 used panther) and 10 at the morning meeting. Ms Rosbach gave a great talk on the history of MPA

LS Unity Day – PA bought orange socks and t-shirts for kids that didn't have them that day. All were used.

3 – Upcoming

Book Festival – "what's your story?" Starts January 16. LS will write/illustrate stories in hard cover books provided by the PA. MS will design the t-shirt. Volunteers are plentiful (old and new families). Will have MS 'staff picks' for books and hope the book sellers can order these books. Same book sellers from past years – proceeds from book sales go to library. Book Festival no longer funding the library. Will encourage the library to use micro-funding for their needs. Money from the event wasn't included in the library budget – bonus money for them.

MS Café -2 day event, not a fundraiser, just a fun event for the kids. Trying to simplify things this year. Addendum Books will be there. Six Chamber will also be there. Will be a Barnes and Noble type café. Fauxcinos and bubble teas. First official meeting 11/10.

Hosting a twin cities mom event – breakfast with Santa on December 3. PA to decorate.

Pancake Breakfast – 12/6 – same decorations used from the breakfast with Santa.

LS 100th Day Celebration in February – Mrs P wants to make a quilt, each kid to get a square.

Sports Swap – Sign up genius for volunteers. \$2, 5, and 10 items. Week after Thanksgiving. In conjunction with Sports Week.

MS PA sponsored event – Discounted tickets to see Wonder. \$8 instead of \$11.50. November 20 @ 5:15. 5th – 8th grades. Each grade to use their funds to pay for tickets? Parents invited as well.

Pies for teachers – Aamodt's to donate 120 apple pies. Pies will be set out in work room for teachers to take.

Holiday Gift Wrapping -12/11. Sign-up genius for volunteers. Have a lot of leftover supplies, but will shop for what is needed.
